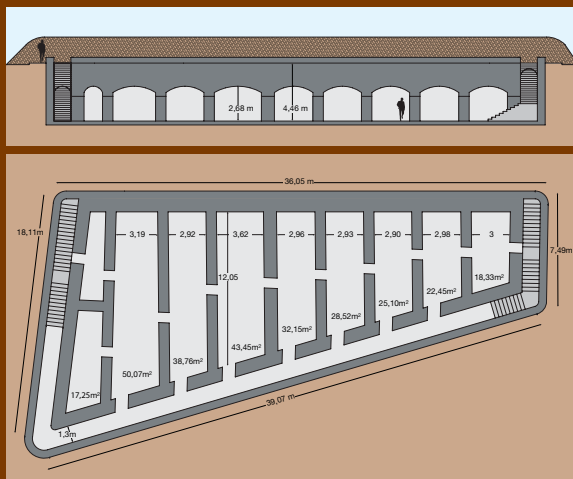

## Jardí de la Infància shelter

Cellular-type underground shelter built in 1938, during the Spanish Civil War (1936-1939), as a response to the air raids which, for the first time in history, were being carried out systematically against the civilian population in non-combat zones. The shelter was built from reinforced concrete and originally covered with an earth mound of over 2 metres high. It was designed to withstand the direct impact of a bomb of up to 100 kg and provide protection against air attacks for over 600 persons.
