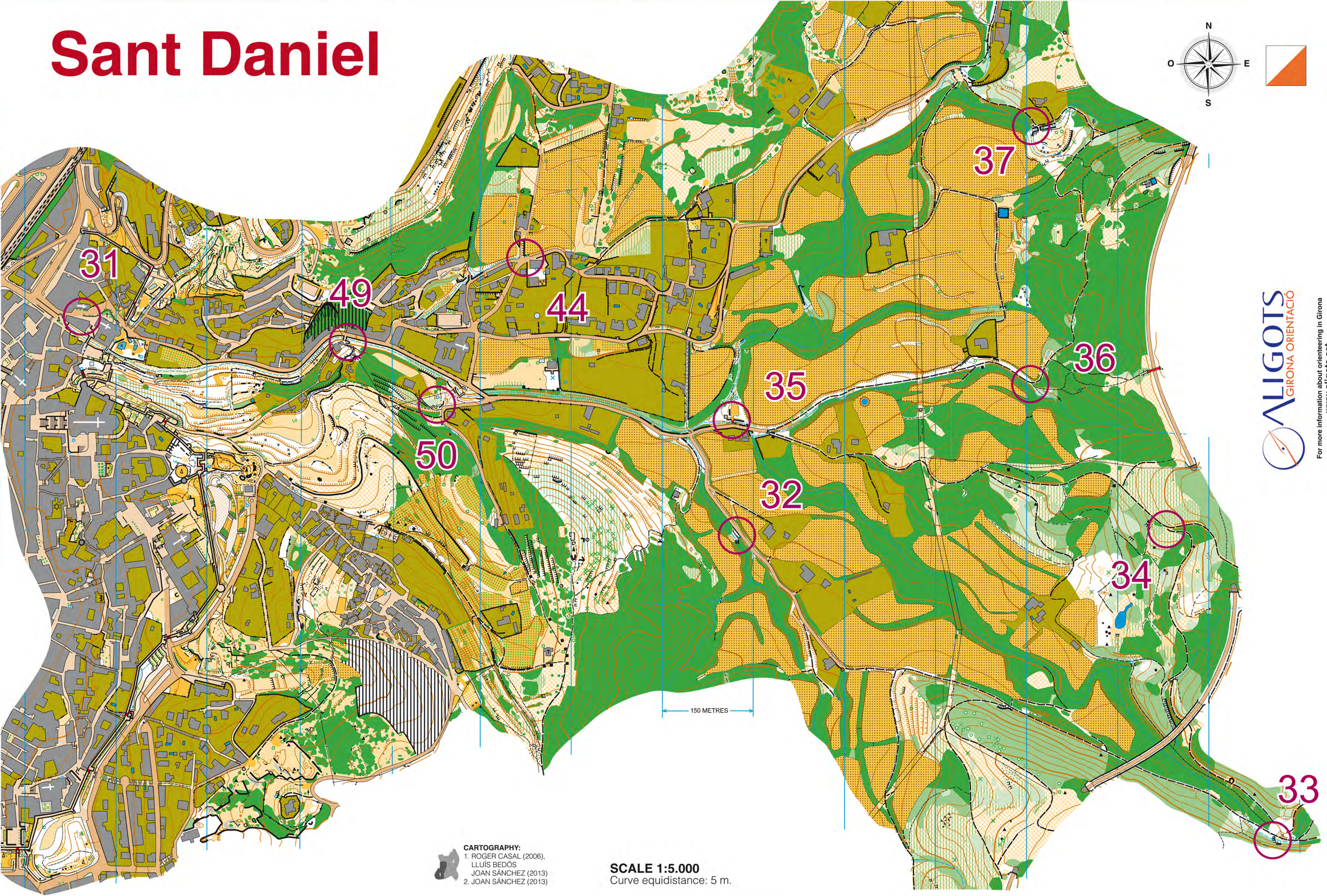
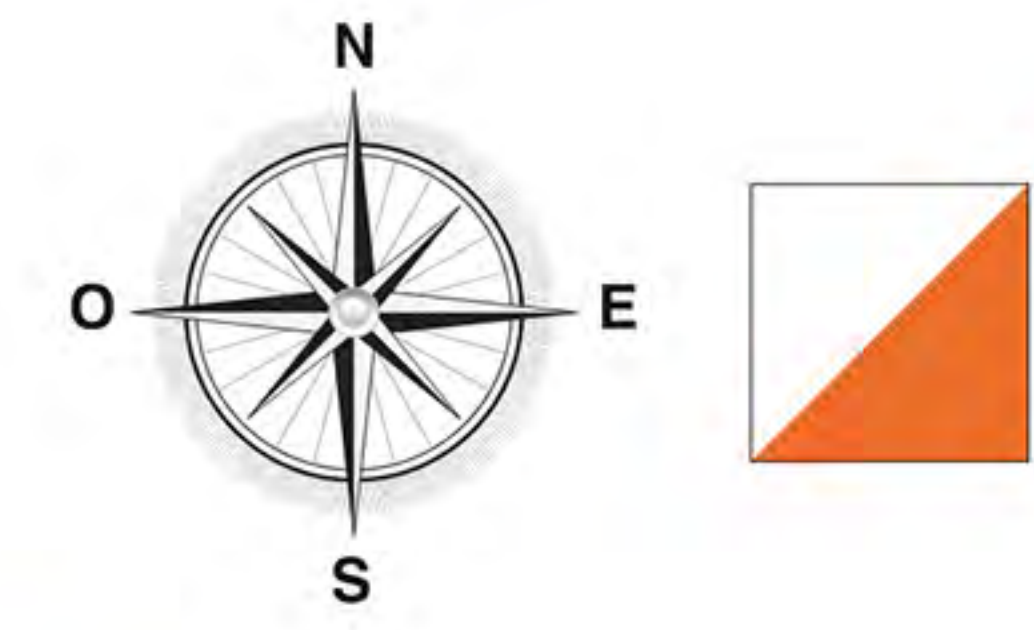

31	Sant Pere de Galligants, fence. Home of the Archaeological Museum and one of the most important monuments of Catalan Romanesque art.
32	Font d'en Fita natural spring, telephone post. Also known as the Font dels Gossos (the dogs' spring), this very popular spring is easy to access.
33	Font dels Lleons natural spring, sign. The name of this spring comes from the crest that decorated it, which belonged to the Bishop of Girona Tomàs de Lorenzana, who was born in León.
34	Gavarres massif, sign. Mid-Mediterranean mountain range, dominated by oaks, cork trees and pines and protected as a Site of Natural Interest.
35	Plaça de les Sardanes, railings. Confluence of several streams where you can see the remains of an old stepped structure where <i>cobla</i> bands used to play.
36	Sant Daniel valley, sign. Agriculture and farming have always been the main economic activities in the valley.
37	Font del Ferro, panel. The name of this spring comes from the sharp taste of iron (<i>ferro</i> in Catalan) of the water that flows from it.
44	Saint Daniel's Schools, fence. The old municipality of Saint Daniel was absorbed into Girona in 1963. This building formed part of the town's former schools.
49	Font del Bisbe, railing. At the Bisbe (Bishop) fountain, the water flows through a metal spout emerging from the head of an imaginary animal carved in stone.
50	Font d'en Pericot, panel. This source is linked to a famous legend in Girona, the legend of the snake of the Pericot fountain.
